PCOM Georgia's Summer Math and Science Academy (SMSA) is a two-week enrichment program to be held June 14 - 25, 2021, primarily for motivated Gwinnett County high school students interested in exploring the wide variety of healthcare professions available to them. Up to 50 students will have the opportunity to learn from PCOM Georgia's osteopathic medicine, pharmacy, physical therapy, physician assistant, and biomedical sciences students and faculty members, along with professionals in the field.

Thanks to the Office of Diversity and Community Partnerships in addition to grants from Hologic, Inc., the Summer Math and Science Academy is a FREE opportunity especially for students of underrepresented communities, Latinx/ Hispanic & BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People Of Color). SMSA's primary target audience is current 9th, 10th, and 11th graders from underrepresented communities. In the past, participants who have been successful in the program exhibited a passion for science and math, a curiosity about healthcare, and a calling to care for others.

High school students will have the opportunity to learn about healthcare topics, science-based research, team building and collaboration, high school productivity, college and professional school preparation, and virtual presence and etiquette. In addition, they will become familiar with career planning, proper business attire, durable skills (resume writing and interviewing),

financial planning and management, volunteering and so much more!

Depending on the county's health status, the structure of the Academy may be virtual via Zoom with potential opportunities for in-person experiences on the College's Suwanee campus. The program will pair carefully selected PCOM Georgia mentors with the high school students who will learn about their mentors' path to a career in healthcare.
